


Maths

 - Solve missing number problems.


Length and height

Science

Sustainability, seasons and planting

In Science we will be investigating why it is important to care for our planet and how we can do so. We will also be observing the change in season to spring and identifying the changes around us. We will also be planting and observing the growth of our plants over the term.



English

We will be looking at the story 'Wombat goes walkabout' by Michael Morpurgo. We will also be looking at the text 'At the Beach' and writing our own postcards using punctuation such as questions marks and exclamation marks.

Phonics

We will continue to learn new sounds throughout the term and apply these during our phonics lessons. In guided reading lessons we will build fluency and learn how to read with expression whilst answering questions about what we have read.

Geography

In Geography we will be understanding geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom, and of a small area in a contrasting non-European country, specifically Australia.



We will be learning about the 7 continents and 5 oceans.

We will also be using world maps, atlases and globes to identify the continents and oceans studied.

PSHE - Healthy Me

We will be learning how to be healthy, how to make healthy choices, how to keep ourselves clean and healthy, medicine safety and road safety.

RE - Christianity

We will be thinking about the question 'Why was Jesus welcomed like a king or celebrity by the crowds on Palm Sunday? We will identify special people and qualities that we admire, understand parts of the Easter story and begin to understand why Jesus was special to Christians.

Computing

In our computing lessons, we will be learning about data and information and how to group that data.

PE

In our PE lesson we will be focusing on ball skills and maintaining control. The children will practice maintaining control of the ball whilst moving in different directions, focusing on moving the ball smoothly rather than with speed.

Music

Design & Technology

- Experience cutting soft fruit and vegetables using appropriate utensils.
- Use the basic principles of a healthy and varied diet to prepare dishes.


