Multiplication and division.

In maths we will be learning to count in steps of 2, 5 and 10.

We will be learning to solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays. We will be working on making equal groups by sharing and grouping.



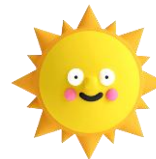
Fractions

In Science we will be learning:

- To identify and name the parts of a plant
- To identify and name the parts of a tree
- To identify and name wild and garden plants
- To identify and name deciduous trees
- To identify and name evergreen trees

English

Poetry - Riddles

Year 1 will be learning about the type of poetry known as a riddle. We will create our own riddles based on the Julia Donaldson book 'Monkey Puzzle'.

Non-Fiction - Julia Donaldson

We will also be learning how to write a biography about one of our favourite authors, Julia Donaldson. We will be learning about the structure of a biography and how to use facts and information to create a piece of writing.

Fiction - Journey Tale

We will also be learning how to write a short journey tale using one of our favourite Julia Donaldson stories, The Snail and The Whale.

We will continue to learn new sounds throughout the term and apply these during our phonics lessons. In guided reading lessons, we will build fluency and learn how to read with expression whilst answering questions about what we have read.

PSHE - Relationships



This term we will be learning how to make friends, solve friendship problems, help others feel included, show respect to others, know how to help others and themselves when they feel hurt or upset and know and show what makes a good relationship.

RE - Judaism

This term we will be looking at Judaism and thinking about the question 'Who is God to the Jews?'. We will identify the special relationship that Jews have with God and discover how Judaism began.

History

In History we will be looking at the lives of significant women in history.

The women we will be investigating are Florence Nightingale, Marie Curie, Amelia Earhart, Mae Jemison and Malala Yousafzai. In this unit, children will explore how these women changed the world. The children will research and create their own picture fact files on what they have learnt.

Art & Design

In our weekly art lesson, we will be looking at notable female artists - Georgia O'Keeffe and Yayoi Kusama. The children will learn how to use painting to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination. They will learn how to recognise and describe some simple characteristics of a range of paintings, from different histories and cultures, including contemporary.
