Physical Development

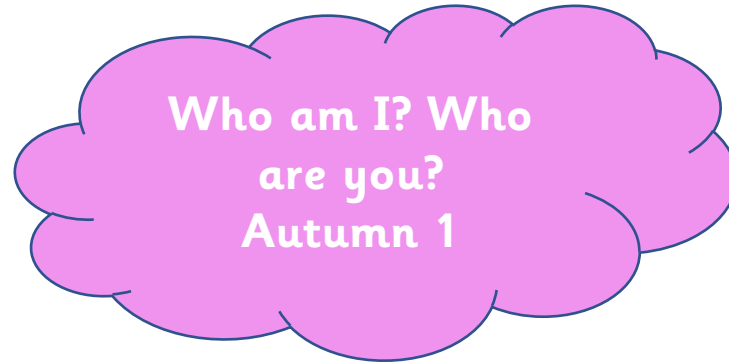
We will be:

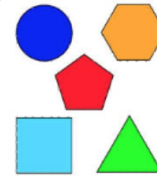
