To recap knowledge of electricity and circuits.

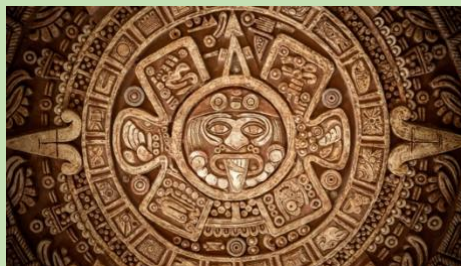
To investigate ways in which the brightness of a bulb or speed of a motor is changed.
